in consideration of Eight hundred dollars to me paid in hand by James  
W. Thompson the act. of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained,  
sold, and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto  
said Thompson that parcel or tract of land lying on Saluda River  
known by the name of Mr. Harris' tract containing three hundred  
and thirty nine acres more or less, being a part of a tract of land  
granted to William Young the fifth day of June 1786 Conveyed by Wm.  
Young to W<sup>m</sup>. Matthews Jr. and from part of said land conveyed to W<sup>m</sup>  
Matthews Jr. and conveyed by W<sup>m</sup>. Matthews Jr. to Jno. Blankenship and  
conveyed from Jno. Blankenship to Mr. Harris the balance of said land  
conveyed by Gen: Jno. Blapin game and Samuel Townes to Mr. Harris and  
together with all and singular the rights, hereditaments & appertain-  
ces to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertain-  
ing. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before men-  
tioned unto the said Jas. W. Thompson his heirs & assigns forever and  
so hereby warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises  
unto the said J. W. Thompson his heirs and assigns against all claim  
whatsoever witness my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of  
October in the year of our Lord 1831. - signed, sealed in the

the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged, have given, granted, bargained, sold, released and  
conveyed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, release and  
convey unto Baylis J. Earle, Remmell Cleveland Senr. Richard Thompson  
Reclina Harrison and George Fleming Esquires, Trustees of the Baptist  
Church to be erected near the village of Granville and their  
successors in office all that lot, piece or parcel of land situated  
lying and being in the District of Granville in the State of South  
Carolina on the eastern boundary of said village: Beginning at  
a stake at the east end of Avenue Street, thirty five feet from the  
East corner of Mr. Crawfords Lot on a direct line with said street  
running thence N. 16 E. forty feet to a stake stand S. 74 E. one hundred
