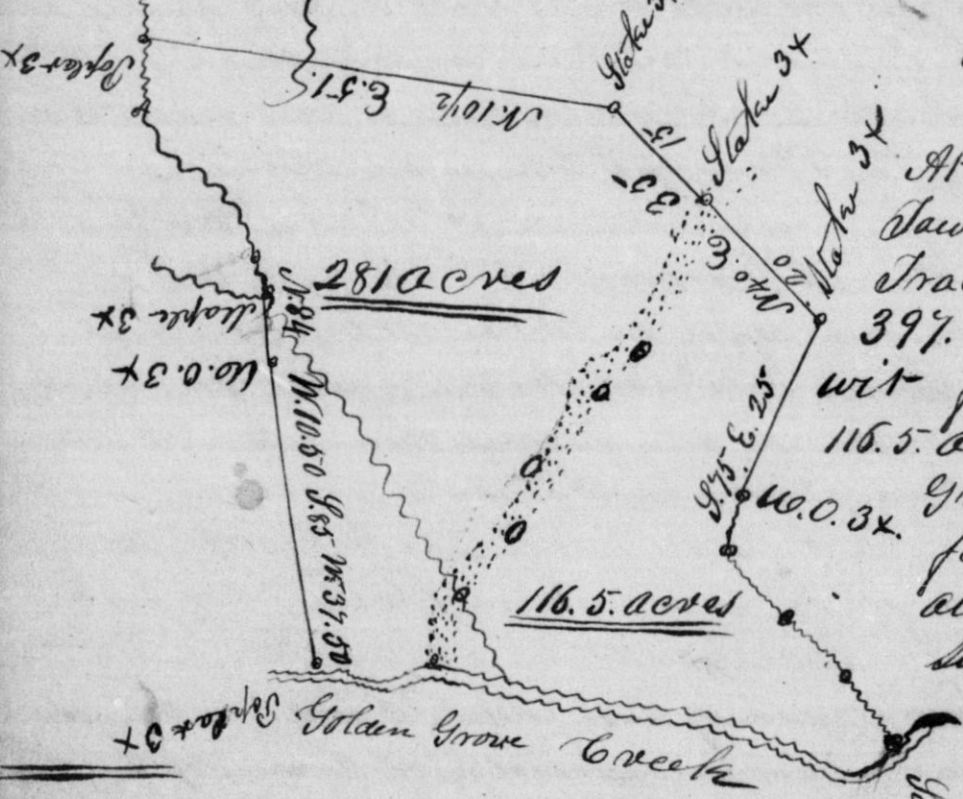

State of South Carolina Greenville District of the State and District aforesaid I, E. W. Dumas one of the Justices of the Quorum do hereby certify unto all whom it may concern, that the wife of the above named John Townsend did this day appear before me, and upon being privately and separately examined by me did declare that she does freely, voluntarily and without any compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, renounce, release, and for ever relinquish unto the above named J. Landon Gregorie his, heirs, and assigns also in Trust, all her interest and estate and also all her right and claim of Dower of in or to all and singular the Premises above mentioned and released.
