these presents do bargain sell and Release unto the said George
Bain his heirs and assigns all that tract or Parcel of Land where
on I now live in said district containing Twenty five and a half
acres be the same more or less being part of a tract originally granted
to Benjamin Pollard as by reference to the Grant will appear beginning
on a hickory 3x now obliterated on Lastys Branch thence N 25 E 23
50 to a pine 3x thence N 36 W 3.50 to a small pine 3x thence N 50 E
5 to a dead Black Jack 3x thence S 33 E on Mary Sandfords line
19.50 to Lastys Branch thence up the same by the meanders
thereof to the Beginning to have and to hold all and singular
the premises above described together with the rights members
hereditaments and appertainances thereunto belonging or in any
wise Incident or appertaining unto the said George Bain his heirs
and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
&c to Warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said
George Bain and his against myself and mine and against
Every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 22nd day of January
