by George Bain of the said State and district have Granted Bargained  
Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and  
Release unto the said George Bain his heirs and assigns a tract or parcel  
of Land in the said district containing Thirty acres be the same more  
or less Beginning on a post oak canal on said Bains line thence N 25  
E 54 chains to a pine corner thence N 36 W 4 chains to a small pine thence  
S 35 W 7 chains to a small dogwood thence S 44 W 12.50 to a red oak sap-  
-lin thence S 12 W 33 chains to the Beginning it being part of a tract  
of Land conveyed to me by Lewis Rodgers as by Reference to the  
deed will fully appear to have and to hold the premises above  
Described forever Together with all and singular the rights members  
hereunto and appertinances therunto belonging or in any  
wise Incident or appertaining and I do hereby bind myself heirs  
Executors &c to Warrant and forever defend the said premises  
against myself and them and against all other persons Lawfully  
Claiming the same or any part thereof in Witness whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April  
one thousand Eight hundred and thirty two
