


Bargain Sell and release all that tract of Land lying in the State and district on

 thence down the mianders of the Creek to a stake thence N 24 E 46 to a red oak thence to the  
 Beginning corner and forty acres on same side of the Creek being part of tract deeded  
 to Said Stokes by Gambling or being all the part of the Gambling tract of Land  
 on the said side of the Creek Where the said Monday lives adjoining the above tract  
 together with all and singular the rights members appertinances to the said prem  
 ises belonging or in any wise incident to have and to hold unto the said Coleman  
 13 Monday his heirs Executors administrators &c and I hereby Warrant the title from

 aforesaid in consideration of Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Peter Taylor of the  
 State and district aforesaid have Granted Bargained Sold and Released and by  
 these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the Said Peter Taylor a tract or  
 parcel of Land of forty acres be the same more or less it being part of a tract of  
 Land Granted to Robert Pinner Lying on the Waters of the meadow fork of Mush  
 Creek Beginning on a maple on the meadow fork of Mush Creek Running N 56  
 E 30 to a stake thence N 25 W 50 to a pine stump thence S 60 W 32.50 to a maple on  
 Said Meadow fork thence down the mianders of Said Meadow fork to the Beginning corner  
 together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appertinances  
 to the said Land and premises belonging or in any wise appertaining thereunto  
 to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
 Said Peter Taylor his heirs and assigns and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
 Executors administrators to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the  
 Said premises unto the Said Peter Taylor his heirs and assigns against my  
 self and all other persons Whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
 or any part thereof as Witness my hand and seal in the year of our Lord
