-ration of the sum of six hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James Kilgore  
of the State and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James  
Kilgore all that tract plantation or parcel of Land containing three hundred  
and five acres be the same more or less it being a part of a tract originally  
Granted to Jonathan Downes also a part of a tract Granted to James Dillard  
and the Ballance being a part of a tract Granted to Bath Birdsong Situate in  
the State and district aforesaid on Both sides of the horse pen Creek waters of  
Gilders Creek Waters of Enoree River Including the plantation whereon John Swinton  
and Vines Harris did live Beginning at a stake corner on Downs N. line and runs  
N 45 E 55 chains to Vines Harris thence up the meanders of said branch to a maple  
corner on John Jones line thence on said line S 67 E 26 chains and 94 links to a  
post oak old made for Dillard's Survey thence on said line S 46 W 17 chains  
and 6 links to an ash corner thence S 33 E 45 chains 50 links to a post oak corner  
thence S 50 W 24 chains to a chestnut corner thence N 36 W 15 chains 50 links to a  
Wickery corner thence S 68 W 9 chains 29 links to a stake corner thence S 45 E 7 chains  
to a chestnut corner thence S 45 W 16 chains 50 links to a post oak corner thence N 40  
W 48 chains to the Beginning Together with all and singular the rights members  
Here detourments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any  
wise Incident or appertaining to the same To have and to hold all and singular  
the premises before mentioned unto the said James Kilgore his heirs and assigns  
forever and I do bind myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns  
to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
the said James Kilgore his heirs Executors administrators and assigns against  
myself my heirs Executors administrators for ever and against the legal  
claim Challenge or demand of all and every person or persons whomsoever  
claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 12<sup>th</sup>  
day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
thirteen and in the thirty seventh year of the American Independence
