Know all men by these presents that I John Lucas of Spartanburg district for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Crane of Greenville district have granted bargained sold and released, and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Samuel Crane a tract or plantation of land, laying and being in the District of Greenville on both sides of a fork of Olisha Thompsons Beaverdam Creek, whereon Edward Watson formerly lived - beginning at a Pine corner thence South course to a Red Oak; thence Eastwardly to the Creek, up the same to an Original line including the Round Bottom, thence along the old line to a Red Oak near the wagon Road thence near a No. course with the Road to a Post Oak thence a straight line to the beginning containing by estimation, One Hundred Acres be the same more or less the same being the West end of a survey made and granted originally to Joseph McCool and Edward Watson, and whereon the said Charles Crane now lives together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said premises belonging or in any way appertaining to have and to hold the above-mentioned premises unto the said Samuel Crane, his heirs and assigns forever. And I, the said John Lucas do hereby bind myself my heirs and Executors to warrant and defend the said premises unto the said Samuel Crane, his heirs or assigns against me and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Fifteenth day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety and Forty second year of American Independence
