Bargained and sold and by these presents do grant Bargain Sell and Release  
unto the Said Felix Green his heirs Executors administrators &c all that tract or  
parcel of land situate lying and being in the state and district aforesaid in the  
fork between Enoree River and Rocky Creek Originally Granted to Daniel Huger  
Esqr being part of a grant made to the Said Huger for four hundred acres on  
the the thirteenth day of October seventeen hundred and eighty four, Beginning  
at a red Oak <sup>3</sup> on the River Bank on the Boundary line and running south  
to Rocky Creek thence down the meanders of the Creek to the River thence up the  
River to the Beginning corner as Represented by the plat containing two hun-  
dred acres more or less together with all and singular the Right ~~more or less~~  
premises & appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident to have  
and to hold I bind myself my heirs Executors administrators &c unto the Said  
Felix Green his heirs Executors administrators &c to Warrant and Defend all the  
aforesaid premises unto the Said Felix Green his heirs Executors administrators &c  
and from myself my heirs Executors administrators &c and from every person  
or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof given under my  
hand and Seal this 14<sup>th</sup> March eighteen hundred and thirty two
