W. 2. 90 to a post oak 3x thence S. 68. W. 3. 50 to a spanish oak 3x thence S. 32. E. 2. 50 to a stone 3x on Seaburns line thence N. 53. E. 1. 22 to a post oak 3x thence to the beginning containing one acre and a quarter be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Trustees or their Successors or should there become and established church at any time hereafter then and in that case to the Deacons and members of said church for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to
