

Release unto the Said Alfred Hightower a certain tract or parcel of Land containing ninety three acres and one 1/2 be the same more or less Situate Lying and being in the State and district aforesaid on both sides of the north fork of Saluda River adjoining the Said Hightowers land it being a part of two tracts of land the S. E. part originally granted to John Malin the N. W. part originally granted to John Hodges and hath such Boundaries as follow (Viz) Beginning on a poplar corner on the top of the mountain on the S. E. side of the river thence N. 65.° W. 52. chains 50 crossing the River at the mouth of the mill creek thence up the mill creek to a Stake corner at the mouth of a hollow thence N. 76.° W. 59. chains to a stake corner on Goodwyns line near a hickery corner thence from the Hickery corner N. 80. E. 9. chains 50 links to a red oak corner thence S. 38. E. 14 chains 90 links to a hickery corner thence S. 19. W. 15 chains to a black oak corner thence S. 26. E. 20 chains to a black gum corner thence S. 31. E. 4 chains 50 links to a beach corner thence S. 55. E. 5 chains to a stake corner thence S. 85. E. 10 chains to a stake corner thence S. 20. E. 6. chains to a mulberry corner thence S. 35. E. 31 chains 50 links to the beginning corner

Together with all and singular the rights and members hereditaments and appertainances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to the Said Alfred Hightower his heirs and assigns forever, and I the Said Hodges do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Said Alfred Hightower his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person or persons Whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In Witness Whereof I have thereunto set my hand and Seal this thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three and in the fifty seventh year of the Independence of the united States of America
