A. Saggart & others to me directed commanding me that of the Goods and Chattels lands and Tenements of J. W. Thompson to Levy the Sum of Twelve hundred dollars Damages and costs I have seized and taken of the Lands and Tenements of the Said James W. Thompson all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land containing three hundred and forty acres Situate and being in the district of Greenville bounded by lands of W. E. Wickliffe John Watson & William Johnson & the Saluda River known by the name of John Harris Tract For amore particular Reference see conveyance in books office from J. B. Williams to the Said J. W. Thompson And whereas the Said premises with their appertinances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been exposed to Sale at public Vendue and purchased by J. H. Jones & R. A. Means of Laurens and Fairfield districts for the Sum of three hundred dollars being the highest Sum that was bidden therefor

Now know ye that I William Blasingame Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and Inconsecration of the said Sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the Said J. H. Jones & R. A. Means the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the Said Thomas J. Jones & R. A. Means their heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of Land with its appertinances and all the Estate Right title and Interest which the Said James W. Thompson of right had of in and to the same to have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of Land with its appertinances unto the Said J. H. Jones & R. A. Means their heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the Said William Blasingame might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise In Witness whereof I the Said William Blasingame have hereunto set my hand and seal
