

Granted Bargained and Sold unto the Said James Bennie a certain tract
or parcel of land containing one hundred and forty five acres be the
Same more or less Lying on the Waters of Reedy River Beginning on a double
Chesnutt oak on Miles Gales line thence the original line N. 40. E. to corner
litwood Stake thence N. 30. W. 44. 72. crossing the forks of Reedy River
to a red oak corner thence S. 60. W. to corner Stake on said miles Gales
on the Branch thence with said Gales line to the Beginning corner
Including all the land within the Boundary except 15 acres that has been
deeded to Said James Bennie for a mill Seat as by Reference to the Grant
will be made fully to appear and Including the land and premises
within the boundaries except the 15th acres as before Excepted for a mill seat
With all Water and Water courses Timber and Profits and ameliorations
or any part thereof With all and Singular the Rents Issues and Profits
Hereditaments Incident or appertaining to the Said one hundred and
forty five acres more or less and further the Said Jourdain Batson
does Covenant with Said James Bennie and does warrant and forever
Defend the above named premises aforesaid from himself his heirs
Executors and assigns and from every other person or persons lawfully
claiming the same or any part thereof to the Said James Bennie his
heirs and assigns forever in Witness Whereunto I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 19th day of August 1833 and in the fifty
eighth year of the Independence of the United States of America
