 containing one hundred and fourteen acres more or less lying and being in the  
 district of Greenville aforesaid on Hoopers Creek and bounded as follows, by Land  
 of James Farr, John Farr and Jeremiah Cleveland also Moses Bitchetts Land the  
 Same being Granted to Peter Freeman and Francis Bremer on the Sixth day of  
 March 1786 by his Excellency William Moultrie Esqr Governor and Commander  
 in Chief for the time being and by the Saia Freeman and Bremer conveyed  
 unto Moses A Smith and by Saia Smith unto James Farr Sent and lastly  
 from James McDaniel Sheriff of Greenville district to myself also an other tract  
 of Land containing one hundred acres more or less Situate lying and being  
 in the Same district of Greenville above mentioned on the North Side of Saluda  
 River and bounded as follows, it being a part of a tract of Land granted to William  
 Smith Stephens the original Grant being for three hundred acres Beginning  
 on a <sup>13</sup>red oak on the North bank of Saluda River at the mouth of a branch  
 thence South Seventy nine degrees East eighteen chains to a red oak on William G  
 Turners line thence South thirty Seven degrees West to a post oak Saplin on Saluda river
