Jolly two tracts of land one of one hundred and sixty three be the same more or less originally granted granted to Daniel Dotson by Grant dated 5<sup>th</sup> of January 1789 and conveyed to Joseph Evans by Theron Earle John Montgomery and John Miller by Deed dated the 27<sup>th</sup> of May 1816 Beginning at a R. oak Running S.W. to achesnut a conditional corner made by Joseph Evans and Solomon Dill Thence N.W. a conditional line to achesnut a corner of Said tract of land thence N. 20. E. to a conditional Chesnut made by William H West and John Dill thence N to a stake a conditional corner thence E to a conditional corner a pine, thence Running a straight line to a conditional corner a black Jack on the old line N. E. to a post oak and Chesnut thence S. 6. E. 44. 20 to achesnut thence S 65. W. 7 to a black jack thence N 90.
