 the district aforesaid on Rocky Creek Waters of Enore River which Samuel Walker decessed  
 to Thomas and Rebecca Hudson conveyed it to the said Lyn Walker now the said  
 Lyn Walker to John D. Smith Together with all and singular the rights members  
 Hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises Belonging or in any
