and to hold forever from us our heirs assigns &c unto the Said William A  
Jerry his heirs and assigns administrators &c and against any other person  
or persons lawfully claiming the Same or any part thereof In Testimony  
Whereof We do hereby set our hands and affix our seals this first day of October  
A.D 1833 and in the fifty. Seventh & fifty Eighth year of the Independence of  
these united States
