and thirty four between John Watson Ordinary for the district aforesaid and
Benjamin M Lynch of the same State and district Whereas a summons in Partition
on to Divide or sell a certain tract of land herein after described of the estate
of Stephen Pace Deceased issued from the Court of Ordinary of said district and
upon the return thereof the Judge of said Court did determine that the said
Land could not be divided without injury to the interest of the parties and
did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the district aforesaid on a
credit of twelve months whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise
the said land for sale on the first Monday in June A.D. 1833 and
Whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on day aforesaid expose to sale at public
outcry on the credit aforesaid the said land when the said Benjamin M
Lynch was the last and highest bidder to whom the said land was struck
off for the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars Now this Indenture
Witnesseth that in consideration of one hundred and sixty dollars to me
several to be paid I have granted bargained sold and released and by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release to the said Benjamin M
Lynch his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of land situate in said
District on the waters of Tyger River containing two hundred and thirty
one and one half acres more or less and $\frac{1}{4}$ th such farm lands &c as are
represented in the annexed plat with the appurtenances thereto belonging
and all the estate right title interest claim or demand which the said
Stephen Pace deceased at the time of his death had in or to the same
to have and to hold the said tract of land together with all and singular
the premises improvements and appurtenances to the said Benjamin M
Lynch his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof I the said John
Watson as ordinary aforesaid have hereunto set my hand and seal
