


State of South Carolina } Know all men by these presents that I Blackman Ligon of

 consideration of Six hundred dollars to me paid by Mary H. Mcgregor of Greenville
 District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the Said Mary H. Mcgregor one hun-
 dred and Eighty nine acres it being more or less and part of two tracts of land
 near Parris Ford on Saluda River which was granted by his Excellency William
 Moultrie unto William Benson the 5th day of June 1786 as appears by a grant Records
 in the Secretaries office in Grant Book K. H. K. H. page 713 Beginning on a corner
 White oak thence N. 7. E. 14. 50 to a stake thence N 93 West to an ash 2, thence N. 7. E. 34
 to a red oak thence N. 61. E. 13 to a post oak thence N. 62. E. 22. 40 to a red oak
 S. 54. E. 23. 75 to a pine thence S. 70. W. 26. 75 to a white oak thence S. 55. E. 2 to a ash
 and thence down the Meanders of the Branch to the Beginning Together with all
 and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appertinances to the Said
 Land belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the Said Mary H. Mcgregor
 his heirs and assigns forever and I do bind myself my heirs Executors and
 administrators to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the Said premises
 unto the Said Mary H. Mcgregor his heirs and assigns against myself and
 against Every other person Whomsoever lawfully claiming the Same or any
 part thereof Witness my hand and Seal this 18th day of December in the year
 of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three and in the 58th year
 of the Independence of the united States of America




