S Thompson and her Brother or Sister or Brothers or Sisters as aforesaid
with out in any way being liable to the debts or contracts of her Father
or any Incumbrance which he may attempt to make her liable for
Nevertheless the true Intent and meaning of this deed of Gift is that the
mother of the Said Sarah S Thompson is not to be deprived of the
Service of the Said Negro Mary untill her Daughter shall arrive at the
age of twenty one or is married in Witness Whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 28th day of March 1834
