

State of South Carolina } This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of  
 Greenville District } February in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight hundred and thirty three Between John Watson Ordinary for the dis-  
 trict aforesaid and Elijah Farmer of the same State and District Whereas  
 a summons in partition to divide or sell a certain tract of land herein  
 after described of the estate of James Farmer deceased issued from the  
 Court of Ordinary of Said District and upon the return thereof the Judge  
 of Said Court did determine that the Said Land could not be divided  
 without Injury to the parties in Interest and did order the same to be  
 sold by the Sheriff of the district aforesaid on a credit of one and two  
 years Whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the Said Land  
 for Sale on the first Monday in December A.D 1832 and Whereas the  
 Sheriff aforesaid did on the Said day expose to Sale at Public outcry  
 on the credit aforesaid the Said Land when Elijah Farmer was the  
 last and highest bidder to whom the Said Land was struck off for  
 the sum of Seven Hundred dollars Now this Indenture witnesseth  
 that in Consideration of Seven Hundred dollars to me paid or secured  
 to be paid I have granted Bargained Sold and released and by these  
 presents do grant Bargain Sell and release to the Said Elijah Farmer  
 his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of land situate in Said  
 District on Grobe Creek of Saludia River containing three hundred  
 acres be the same more or less begining on Said Creek at the mouth  
 of a branch known by the name of Terry's Spring Branch which  
 separates Said Land from Benjamin Townsend's Land and running  
 up the meanders of said Branch to a white oak at the head of said  
 Branch thence South 75° E. 24 to a stake on Bowes old line thence N. E. 42  
 34 to a pine knot corner thence S. E. 48. 25 to a branch which was man-  
 a conditional line between Samuel and John Ware then down said  
 Branch to its confluence with the Little Grove Creek then down the  
 Little Grove to John Bowes line now Philip Evans thence S. E. 42. 37 to the Golden Grove Creek thence  
 up said Creek dividing the land herein described and Philip Evans  
 Land to the begining the above described is a part of three tracts one part  
 granted to Merideth Blackburn of 53 acres one part of 94 acres to Sam  
 Bradley and the other part of 135 acres to Nathaniel Head together with  
 the appertinances therunto belonging and all the estate right little In  
 terest claim or demand which the Said James Farmer deceased at  
 the time of his death had in or to the same to have and to hold the  
 Said tract of land together with all and singular the premises Im-  
 provements and appertinances to the Said Elijah Farmer and his  
 heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof I the Said John Watson
