 Greenville District } for the sum of twenty dollars to me in hand paid by James McDaniel of the district and State aforesaid have granted and sold unto the said James McDaniel six acres of land more or less in the district aforesaid beginning on a post oak on the line between McDaniel and myself and running a north course 3 chains to a small Hickey in the Edge of the old field thence an East course 16 chs to a hickery corner near a spanish oak corner on McDaniel's line thence ~~west~~ S course on McDaniel's line 7 chains to a post oak corner on the head of the Shop Branch thence an W course on the Division line between McDaniel and myself 16 chains to the beginning which six acres of land more or less I Warrant to the said McDaniel his heirs and assigns for ever against me my heirs and all other persons lawfully Claiming the same Given under my hand this 23<sup>d</sup>
