N. 46. W. 12. 50 to a black oak on the bank of Shoal Creek and thence  
up the said Shoal Creek to the Beginning containing twenty four  
acres more or less as the annexed Plat will fully show together  
with all and singular the rights members & hereditaments &

acres more or less beginning on a white oak thence running west on the  
old line to Spanish oak thence running south on the conditional  
line made between the said Howard and Pitman thence East along the  
Road to a cherry tree thence to the Spring Branch to a beach on the creek  
thence to Chestnut thence running to a Spanish oak on the conditional
