 Greenville District } Ephraim Heffner for the consideration of  
 Four hundred dollars to me paid by James Ginsley of the said district  
 and State aforesaid have granted Bargained and Sold and by  
 these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and release unto the said  
 James Ginsley a certain plantation or tract of land lying and  
 being in Greenville district and State aforesaid on the South  
 Fork of Enoree and the waters hereof beginning on red oak corner  
 near the Edge of the meadow thence long with a ditch a straight  
 course to the old mill from thence with the Meanders of the  
 said creek opposite a stake corner from thence S. 80 West  
 92 chains to a post oak thence N. 10 E. 70 chains to a red oak  
 thence 65 East to a stake opposite the head of a branch thence  
 square thence square to the head of the branch thence down  
 said branch to the mouth thence down the main branch  
 opposite a old fence row thence with the old fence row to a  
 Spanish oak corner near James Bollings Barn from thence  
 22 1/2 East to the S. fork of Enoree thence down the meander  
 of the said creek to the old path to a white oak corner  
 thence North 58 East 19 chains 40 links to a white oak near  
 the head of a spring thence S. 81 East 15 chains to a small  
 Hickory thence S. 20 East 8 chains to the beginning together  
 with all and singular the rights members here pertaining  
 and appurtenances belonging or in any wise apper-  
 taining to have and to hold all and singular the  
 above mentioned land and premises unto the said James  
 Ginsley his heirs and assigns forever and I heely bind  
 myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend the said land and premises unto  
 the said James Ginsley his heirs and assigns and again-  
 -st myself my heirs and assigns and all other persons  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part  
 thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
 and seal the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1828.
