301 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Abner Jones of the State aforesaid and district of Laurens for and in consideration of Twelve hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas Brynes of the State aforesaid and district of Spartanburgh I have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and assign unto the said Thomas Brynes his heirs and assigns a certain plantation or tract of land containing four hundred acres lying and being in the State aforesaid and district of Greenville on the South side of Durbin Creek beginning at a stake borne of the old tract running thence 65 E. 31 Ch. 25 lks to a stake 37 thence N. 35 E to the said Durbin Creek thence up said Creek thence to where it crosses the old line thence along said line to Mc Clains line thence along said line to Stub Stake borne running thence South west 20 chains 32 links to a stake thence S. 20 W. 60 chains 50 links to a stake S. 70 E to a stake thence N. 54 E. 67 chains 50 links to a stake which includes the land to be conveyed being a certain tract of land granted to William Stuet bearing date the 5th of September 1785 Recorded in Grant Book E E E Page 337 signed by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq then Governour over said State together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the same unto the said Thomas Brynes his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to warrant and forever defend the said premises above mentioned and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators or assigns or any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof unto the aforesaid Thomas Brynes his heirs and assigns forever as witness my hand and seal this 22nd day of September 1834
