South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I Joseph Powell of Greenville district of the district and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid by Jacob Painter of the same state and district have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jacob Painter his heirs and assigns forever a certain lot of land containing one acre situate in the district aforesaid in the town of Greenville it being part of a lot of land to the said Joseph Powell by Wardy Mcbee Esq the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1838 and hath such bounds mark, &c as follow viz: Beginning at a Stake on Ann-matte Street then e N 16 East 5 ch 15 links to a Stake on Washington Street thence S 74 E 1 ch 94 links to a Stake on said Street then e S 16 W 5 ch 15 links to a Stake on an even street thence along said Street N 74 W 1 ch 94 links to the beginning corner together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premise, aforesaid unto the said Jacob Painter his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said Jacob Painter his heirs, and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 26<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine and sixty-third year of the independence of the United States of America.
