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South Carolina I Know all men by these presents that I Joseph M'Cullough Greenville District ^{of} State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and thirty two dollars to me paid by Jesse French of the same place have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jesse French a certain tract or parcel of land containing Two hundred and sixty six and a half acres situate in the state and district aforesaid lying on the waters of Mountain creek Beginning on a post oak 3^x and running thence N 88^{1/2} W 54.30 to a stump 3^x thence S 68 E 29.80 to Spanish oak 3^x bounded by Micajah Stones land thence N 67 E 7 to a stake at a branch thence down the meanders of said branch to mountain Creek bounded by the said Stones land thence N 76 E 48.80 to a stake at the Beaver dam creek thence up the said creek N 12 W 12.00 thence N 11 E 10.00 thence North 7.00 to a stake 3^x thence N 35 W 16.30 to the beginning Together with all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Jesse French his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jesse French his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 23rd January in the year of our Lord 1839 Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of
