Curton two tracts of Land joining lying and being on the south west side of the Rudy fork Creek - beginning on a Young Pine 3x thence South  $20^{\circ} 00'$  10.50 to a Red Oak 3x thence  $S 30^{\circ} W 10^{\circ}$  to a hickory 3x thence  $S 40^{\circ} W 27.80$  to Red Oak 3x thence  $S 54^{\circ} E 58$  chs to Red Oak 3x thence  $N 43^{\circ} E 5.20$  Post oak 3x thence  $S 55^{\circ} E 13.25$  to a stake 3x near a post oak 3x thence  $N 30^{\circ} E 37$  chs to a stake 3x thence  $N 25^{\circ} W 9$  chs to Post oak 3x thence  $N 40^{\circ} W 28$  chs to P. O 3x thence  $N 34^{\circ} E 180$  to a forked red oak 3x thence  $N 23^{\circ} W 16$  chs to a small hickory 3x thence  $N 14^{\circ} E 8.50$  chs to a water oak 3x on the Rudy Fork Creek thence up the said Creek to a black Gum 3x thence  $S 71^{\circ} W 47.75^{\circ}$  a Post Oak thence  $S 20^{\circ} E 24^{\circ}$  to the beginning the said tract containing five hundred and one acres together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned tracts of land unto the said John M.
