State of South Carolina } Greenville District } Know all men by these presents that I Charles Littleton of State of Missouri Howards County for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas Chatman of Greenville District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas Chatman a certain tract or parcel of land lying in Greenville District and State aforesaid on the north side of Saluda River binding on land belonging to Alexander Acker Robert Davinport Humphrey Williams and by the said Saluda River on the south containing fifty acres more or less it being a tract of Land whereon Jimima Littleton formerly lived and being by her Jimima Littleton deeded away in a deed of Gift to sd Charles Littleton which land I do hereby warrant and for ever defend from myself my heirs Executors and Administrators unto said Thomas Chatman and his heirs from myself my heirs Executors & Administrators and from every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any part thereof - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the seventeenth day of November Eighteen hundred and thirty Eight and the 62nd & 63rd of the Independence of the United States of America - Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of A. Acker, A Durham } Ch Littleton Seal
