Executors adm^rs or assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs exec and adm^r
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto said Oliver
his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons

Greenville District Day of August in the year of our Lord One
Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty Nine and in the sixtieth year of the
Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America by Sarah Baker
of the District aforesaid on the one part and by Randall Croft of said District
on the other part witnesseth that the said Sarah Baker for and in consid-
eration of the natural love and affection which she bears to her grand daughter
Anna S D'Vyle and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to her paid
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold
And by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell a negro girl Nancy
and a boy Paul the child of said Negro Slave unto the said Randall Croft in
trust that said Randall Croft shall hold and possess the full and entire right and property
in said slave Nancy and her child Paul together with all the issue and future increase
of said Nancy so that the said property shall not be liable for the debts and contracts of
the said Sarah Baker in any manner whatever but that the right and property
in said slaves and the increase of said female slave shall be held and professed
by the said Randall Croft for the sole use benefit and advantage of the aforesaid
Anna S D'Vyle and in trust that the said Randall Croft
