aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Robert Dickson a certain tract or parcel
of land lying in Greenville District in the State aforesaid on branches of Thompsons
Beaver Dam Creek waters of the Middle fork of Tyger River. Beginning
on a chestnut tree called Asa's corner running thence with said line S 80 E 57
Chains to a Red Oak. thence due South 56 chains to a stake on the original line
thence with said line N 80 W 57 chains to pointers to a Red oak thence
due North 56 chains to the beginning corner. Bounded by lands belonging to
Wm Gibson Asa Cunningham Jefferson Pennington David Mosteller and
Henry Cannon containing Two Hundred and (77) seventy seven acres more or
less. Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and
Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
ing To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Robert Dickson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself
and heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Robert Dickson his heirs and assigns against
myself my heirs and all others lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
