 order of the Court of Equity for Greenville District at June Term 1827 a certified
 copy of which is hereunto annexed and for and in consideration of the sum of one
Thousand Dollars to us in hand paid as such administrators as aforesaid for the benefit
 of said Estate the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge as assets in our hands
 for the payment of debts; Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and release unto Pleasant Moon all that Tract of Land
 and plantation situate in Greenville District on Pyles Branch Waters of Pody River
 containing agreeably to a survey made by G Moore Thre Hundred and Three acres
 be the same more or less Beginning at a small Red oak corner just below where the
 Mill stands running thence S 26 E 16 to a stake corner thence S 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ to a
 stump corner, thence N 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 32.50 to a young Red Oak corner thence N 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ E
 69.50 to a Sourwood corner, thence S 60 E 34 to a stake, thence S 50 E 10.50 to a small
 Red Oak, thence S 47 W 2.75 to the beginning Red Oak corner having such
 other shape bollings & boundings as are represented in a plat thereof made by G Moore
 on the 7th Oct 1835 Together with all and singular the rights, members heredita-
 ments & appurtenances to the sd premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 To Have and to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 Pleasant Moon his heirs and assigns forever and we the said P E Duncan and
 B J Earle as such administrators as aforesaid and by virtue of the said order
 for sale and in pursuance of our said authority do hereby warrant and defend and
 do bind the heirs of the sd Alexander Sloan Deed to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Pleasant Moon against our
 selves and the heirs of the said ~~Alexander~~ Sloan and against all and every
 other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
 part thereof In Testimony whereof we the said P E Duncan and B J Earle as
 such Administrators have hereunto set our hands and seals this the first day
 of November in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty
