 following property Viz Forty Bushels of Corn Two Cows and Calves & One Heifer Nine Head of
 Hogs Two Thousand Pounds fodder One bay Mare One sorrell mare and two mares Saddl
 & Harn and to Hold all and singular the above mentioned property unto the said
 James Jones his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever Provided nevertheless
 and it is expressly agreed between the said parties that if the said Absalom
 Hyde his executors Administrators &c shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid
 unto the said James Jones his certain Attorney Executors Administrators or assigns
 the full sum of seventy five Dollars 75⁰/₄ or before the 25th December of
 1840 then the above bill of sale and every article and thing therein contained shall
