Eight Hundred and thirty nine between John Waton Ordinary  
of Greenville District of the one part and Esabel C. Field of  
said District of the other part witnesseth That whereas the  
said Esabel C. Field stands justly indebted to the said John Waton  
Ordinary as aforesaid his successors in Office or assigns in the  
sum of Eight Hundred and seventy four Dollars and 75 Cents  
for which sum the said Waton holds the note of the said Esabel  
C. Field and Alexander Neal security bearing even date herewith  
and due the seventh day of October A. D. 1840 a reference to which  
note will more fully appear. Now this Indenture witnesseth that  
the said Esabel C. Field for and in consideration of the said debt  
or sum payable as aforesaid, to the said John Waton or his  
successor in Office, and for the better securing the payments  
thereof to the said John Waton or his successors in Office according  
to the tenor and effect of the note aforesaid, and also in consideration  
of the sum of one dollar to the said Esabel C. Field by him the said  
John Waton in hand paid at, and before the sealing and delivery  
of these presents, do grant, bargain, sell, alien, release confirm and  
convey unto the said John Waton Ordinary as aforesaid and to his  
heirs and assigns and his successors in Office forever a tract piece  
or parcel of lands situated in the District of Greenville in the State  
aforesaid on Flat Rock Creek of Quoree River containing three  
Acres and twenty acres more or less, and hath such boundry  
marks &c as follows. viz. Beginning at a P. C. 34 thence S. 40° W 55 ch  
to a Red Oak 34 thence S 50.6 58 chains to a stake 34 thence N. 40. 65 ch
