Have granted, bargained sold and released. And by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Nathan Davis all that tract or parcel of Land containing One hundred & six acres, more or less, situated in Greenville District and State aforesaid on a Branch of Durbin Creek, water of Enoree River. Beginning at a Rock near the Georgia Trade, thence on Jonathan Davis' line S. 62° E 32.50 to a Rock 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  thence on Robert Blakely's line N. 28° E 13 to a Stake 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  thence N. 12° E 22 to a Stake 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  thence N. 60° W 26.50 to a Pine 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  thence on Solomon Jones' line N. 30° W. 34 to the beginning. Together with all and singular the right, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the above described premises to the said Nathan Davis his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Nathan Davis his heirs Executors and assigns against myself and my heirs & against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any part thereof.
