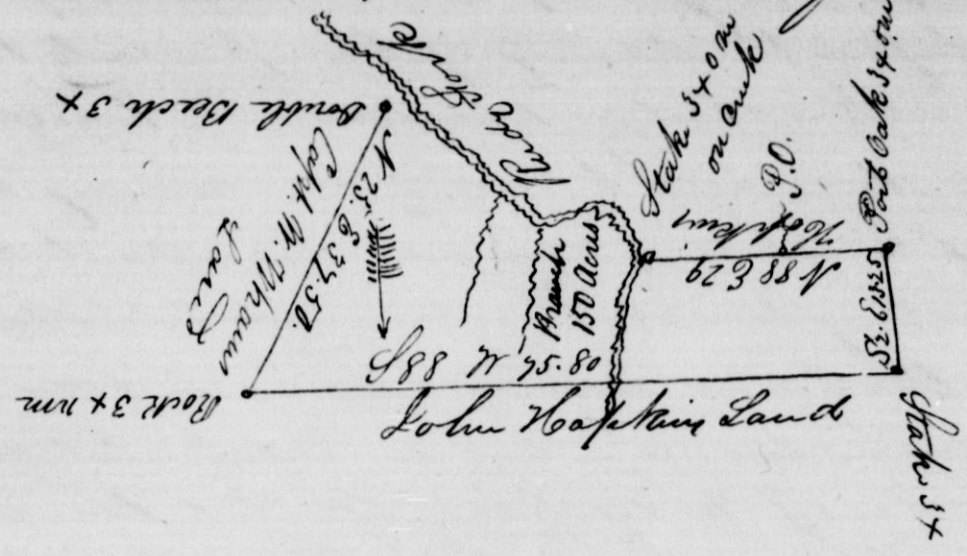

South Carolina <sup>185</sup> Know all men by these presents Greenville District that I Young Ray of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars to me in hand paid by John Cox of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & release unto the said John Cox all that plantation or tract of land lying and being situate in the District aforesaid on the west side of Rocky Creek waters of Reedy River, being part of a tract originally granted to James Seaborn. Beginning on the big road on a stake on the said John Coxes line, thence up said road to James Woodsides line, thence along Woodsides line to John Baldwins line on Rock Creek, thence along said Baldwins line to a chestnut thence S 73. W. 24 ch. 50 L. to the beginning - Containing twenty eight acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the land above mentioned to the said John Cox his heirs and assigns, and against myself and my heirs &c and every other person legally claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Given under my hand & seal this 29th day of September 1836 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty six and in the sixtieth year of the Independence of the united States of America.
