Greenville District, 3 that S. Pearson Payne of the State,
District aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of four dollars
per acre to me paid by Mary W. Lewis, have granted, bargained and
sold unto the said Mary W. Lewis of said District a certain parcel
of Land, it being a part of a Tract of Land originally granted to
John Hammon on the 21st day of January 1785 all that part of
said Tract of land lying West of a Branch that heads in said
Mary W. Lewis Field and South of the original Creek beginning
on a Stake on Mary W. Lewis, original line on the said branch
thence a North course down the meanders of said Branch
to a Stake on the bank, thence down the meanders of said
Creek to a Ironwood corner between Jeremiah Cleveland
and Mary W. Lewis, thence South on the original line
to a Dog Woods corner, thence East on the original line to the
beginning lying in the District aforesaid and on the water of
the Grove Creek. Together with all and singular the right
appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise incident
or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
the premises above mentioned unto the said Mary W. Lewis
her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself
my heirs & executors to warrant and forever defend all and singular
