 red bunches fodder Three Hundred pounds pickled pork Two Beds and  
 furniture Two pots one Cupboard one Chest Four Chairs one pair Pewter &  
 "Your pleasure to have and to hold all singular the above mentioned property  
 unto the said James Jones his Executors administrators and assigns  
 forever provided nevertheless and it is expressly agreed between the said par-  
 ties that if the said Wilford boy his Executors or administrators shall  
 well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto James Jones his certain attorney  
 Executors administrators or assigns the full sum of Eighty four dollars &  
 2<sup>2</sup>/<sub>4</sub> with Interest on or before the twenty fifth day of December Eighteen  
 hundred and forty then the above bill of sale and every article and  
 thing herein contained shall cease & be utterly void otherwise remain  
 in full force & virtue Signed sealed and acknowledged this sixteenth day  
 of Decr One thousand Eight Hundred and thirty nine in presence of the  
 subscribing Witnesses
