 Jones of the District aforesaid the following property (viz) One brown mare one soult  
 Cote two Cows one calf Ten head of Hogs fifteen Barrells of Corn Four hund-  
 red bunches fodder Three Hundred pounds pickled porks Two Beds and  
 furniture Two pots one Cupboard one Chest Four chairs one pair plow gear &  
 Four plows to have and to hold all singular the above mentioned property  
 unto the Said James Jones his Executors administrators and assigns  
 forever provided nevertheless and it is expressly agreed between the said par-  
 ties that if the Said Wilford or his Executors or administrators shall  
 well truly pay or cause to be paid unto James Jones his Certain attorney  
 Executors administrators or assigns the full sum of Eighty four dollars &  
 24/100 with Interest on or before the twentyfifth day of December Eighteen  
 Hundred and forty then the above bill of sale and every article and  
 thing therein contained shall cease & be utterly void other wise remain  
 in full force & virtue Signed sealed and acknowledged this sixteenth day  
 of Decr One thousand Eight Hundred and thirty nine in presence of the  
 subscribing Witnesses

 thence S. 59 E 49 To a Maple thence S 65. E. 1. 75 to the Beginning which contains
