






stake corner then N 69 W. 15 to his Red Oak & then N 20 E. 6 to his maple &
on the pigeon Roost branch then up the same 5 ch to a maple & then N 58
E 30 to pollards corner then south back to the beginning To have & to hold the
premises as aforescribed To the said Henry Lenderman his heirs and assigns
forever. Together with all and singular the rights and privileges belonging
or incident to the same and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defend the same against me &
mine and every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any
part thereof from the said Henry or his heirs assigns Executors or administra-
tors In witness of which I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 21 day of July 1836. In
