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To all whom these presents shall come I David Hennings Sheriff of Greenville district and State aforesaid send greeting Whereas by virtue of sundry Writs of fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville tested the Ninth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred Thirtynine at the suit of Lewis Gibson & Co and others to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of Joseph Powell to levy the sum of Five thousand Six hundred dollars damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Joseph Powell all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing one and three fourths acres situate and being in the District of Greenville and Village of Greenville adjoining lands of W.
