said Recited bond being only as security for the said Vincent Austin  
and at the request as aforesaid he the said Vincent Austin to concur  
in secure him the said William Deavenport against the same hath ag-  
reed to convey and grant all that tract or parcel of land containing  
by computation one hundred and thirty five acres whereon  
John Kirby now lives to him the said William Deavenport his heirs  
and assigns forever in manner and form herein after expressed  
Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Vincent Austin for and in  
consideration of the premises and also for and in consideration of the  
sum of Four hundred and fifty eight dollars to him in hand paid  
by the said William Deavenport at and before the installing & delivery  
hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Vincent  
Austin hath granted bargained sold alienated remised released &  
confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell remise
