To all to whom these presents shall come I  
 David Hemming Sheriff of Greenville District and State aforesaid  
 send Greeting. Whereas by virtue of Sundry Writs of fieri facias  
 issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Gre-  
 enville tested the ninth day of March in the year of Our Lord  
 One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine at the suit of  
 Lewis Gibson & divers others to me directed commanding me  
 that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of Joseph  
 Powell to levy the sum of Five thousand Six hundred dollars  
 damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands and  
 tenements of the said Joseph Powell all that certain piece parcel  
 and tract of land in the plan of the village N<sup>o</sup> 15 117 1/2 feet front  
 on broad Street and 140 feet deep situate and being in the  
 District of Greenville and Village of Greenville known as the  
 Walker Brock Lot adjoining B. J. Horton and others and conveyed  
 by I & H. Brock to Joseph Powell. And Whereas the said premises  
 with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by  
 virtue of the said writs of fieri facias before mentioned have been  
 exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by B. J. Horton  
 of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid for the sum of  
 One hundred and eighty dollars being the highest sum  
 that was bidden therefor. Now know ye that I David Hemming  
 Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid  
 to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the  
 Statute in such case made and provided and for and in con-  
 sideration of the said sum of one hundred and eighty dollars  
 to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Benjamin  
 J. Horton the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknow-  
 ledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do  
 grant bargain and sell unto the said B. J. Horton his heirs  
 and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of Land
