Lewis of the District of Pickens in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by David Blythe of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said David Blythe a certain tract of land included in two Grants a part of one originally granted to Henry Wolf and the other to William D. Bradford. Beginning on a Sycamore on the bank of the South fork of Saluda River in said District of Greenville thence N 15 E 92.00 to a Black gum or stake in the back line of Wolfs Grant thence N 82 E 21.50 on Wolfs back line to a stake thence N 13 W 45.00 to a Chestnut thence N W 75 W 31.50 to a Hickory in Thomas Rowlands line thence with said Rowlands line S 37 W 33.50 to a maple on the bank of the aforesaid River thence down the meander of the River about 20 chl to a Hickory now a P. O. thence S. 67 E 27.00 to a pine thence S. 5 E. 10. to a Stake in Wolfs back line thence S. 85 W 23.00 to a B. C. or Stake thence S 15 W 27.00 to a Hickory on the bank of the River W. H. Stebbins corner thence with the River at it meanders to the beginning Sycamore corner together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
