Thence N 33° W. 13 chains to a Stake in the road 50 links from Post Oak 3 x 3 x or Thence S 40° W 29 chains 50 links to a Steeping Post Oak 3 x. Thence S. 65° E. 44 Ch<sup>s</sup> to a Stake 3 x Thence N 33° E 28 chains 3 x to the beginning corner including eighty Acres of land be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. to have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Stephen Smith and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Stephen Smith his heirs and assigns and against me my heirs and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my name and seal this the 13 day of August 1835.
