Absolum Nelson of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid or secured to be paid by William Brantlett of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Brantlett all that plantation tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the District aforesaid on the south side of South Tyger River. Beginning on a Post Oak stump thence S 84 E 11.40 to a black Gum N 46 E 13.50 to a Post Oak 3 x thence South 80 E 13.50 to a post Oak 3 x thence N 32 E 27.50 to a Sassafras 3 x near on the bank of the River thence up the meanders of the River to a stone a Conditional Corner between said Absolum Nelson and Dennis Crane thence South 32 W 27.50 to the beginning corner containing by estimation one hundred and Ten acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights minerals hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or pertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises to the said William Brantlett his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and assigns to warrant and forever defend the said premises to the said William Brantlett his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against all and every person
