 aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Pesse French
 all that plantation or tract of land containing One hundred and forty
 four acres (more or less) situate in the District aforesaid lying on Saluda
 River beginning on a small white Oak 3x at a branch running thence
 N 12 W 23 chains to a Red Oak 3x thence N 42 E 7.50 to a stake 3x at the
 Horseshoe on Mountain Creek thence down the meanders of said
 Creek to a White Oak 3x not far above the mouth of a branch thence S.
 40 W 25 to a Post Oak 3x thence due West 14.40 to a White Oak + on Saluda
 River thence up the meanders of said River to the Beginning corner
 Together with all and singular the rights hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or
 appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Pesse French his heirs and assigns
 forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and ad-
 ministrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
 premises unto the said Pesse French his heirs and assigns against
 myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
