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The State of South Carolina } Know all men by these presents that William Goldsmith of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of One Hundred Dollars to me paid by William Hale of the State & District aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said William Hale all that tract or parcel of land situate in the State and District aforesaid on the North Fork of Saluda River. Bounded as follows (viz) Beginning on a black jack tree standing upon a line running between George Salmon land and land laid out for Maj John Ford and running on said line both ways from said Black Jack until it joins George Salmon land on one side and John Ford on the other thence with the line of said Salmon's land on the one side and the said Ford's line as the other side until it strikes an old path a conditional line between Benjamin Couch and John Adkins thence along said path to the Old original line joining John Ford's land thence along said line until it includes a certain field called and known by the name of the Cockram field thence to a conditional line marked between John Bates and said John Adkins including One hundred acres of land be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights members tenements hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said William Hale his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Hale his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 24th day of September in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine and in the
