I know all men by these presents that I James Gidley in the
State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred dollars
to me payed by B. Durham in the State aforesaid have granted bargained
sold and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said B. Durham the Remaining undivided One half part of a
parcel or Lot of land containing something less than One half acre situate
lying and being in the District and State aforesaid in the Village of Green-
ville Known and distinguished in Mr. Bee's plan or chart of said Village by
the Number Fifteen (No. 15) being the Remaining undivided One half which
now belongs to me the Other Undivided One half being already conveyed
to the said B. Durham. The lot begins at a Stake border at the corner of
Mauldin's lot on Main Street on the West side of said street running thence
and fronting the said street South 16 West Seventy feet to a Stake corner on
Roberts corner thence N. 74 West Two hundred and thirty five feet to a
Stake on Laurens Street thence along said street and fronting the same
N. 16 E. Seventy feet to a Stake on the corner of Mauldin's lot thence S. 74 E
along the said Mauldin's line Two hundred and thirty five feet
to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Her-
editaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the Prom-
ises before mentioned unto the said B. Durham his heirs and assigns for-
ever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said B. Durham his Heirs and Assigns against me and my Heirs
and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
any part thereof. Witness my hand and Seal this twenty eighth day
of March in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and
Forty and in the Sixty Fourth Year of the Independence of the Unit-
