South Carolina } Know all men by these presents that I Watson
 Greenville Dist } Robts of the State and District aforesd have this
 day made a settlement with G. F. Westmoreland and has given my
 note to D Westmoreland for One Hundred and seventy five dollars
 and 22/100 due one day after date which note will fully appear dated
 31st Oct 1839 for the above amount which I the D Robts do for the
 purpose of securing the debt to D Westmoreland or his assigns do
 bargain sell and release or put in pledge or trust to D Westmoreland
 a certain son of fully three years Old and further give full privilege
 to D Westmoreland to sell D fully at any time by giving public
 notice for cash and place the proceeds thereof to D note or other-
 wise will take her at valuation and D fully to be as Westmoreland
 own right and property untill released by the above note being
 satisfied I do further acknowledge and give in trust all of my
 right title and claim of so much thereof of my part of Corn (viz
 2/3 of the Corn made this year on the Springfield or Robts near
 ground or so much thereof as will satisfy D demand at valua-
 tion the customary price or to be sold by Westmoreland at
 the neightour hood price as he the D Westmoreland deems best
 when the corn is measured to be credited on this Note within
 named also 3/4 of two stacks of fodder in the same field to
 a quantity of Corn & ops deposited at Robts which property
 herein mentioned I do warrant and for ever defend the unde-
 rstanding of the parties Westmoreland & Robts is that the proper-
 ty herein mentioned is put in pledge for the within purpose
 signed sealed and delivered in testimony whereof I set my
 hand and seal in presence of this 31st Oct 1839
