J. Williams above referred to - Together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining:

To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before men-
tioned unto the said William Surpier but his heirs and assigns
forever and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs Executors Adminis-
trators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the prem-
ises to the said William Surpier or his heirs or assigns against mys-
elf and my heirs and all manner of Persons whomsoever lawfully
claimed onto claims the same or any part thereof.
